

NEW ZEALAND

On the 11th and 12th of November 2023 the IHNZ Board met in Hamilton for a two-day planning workshop. The goal of the workshop was to develop short-and long-range goals and to identify the programs and events that we would support in attaining these goals.

As a sport with a small volunteer base, we realised that we must focus our resources both financially and manpower wise to a set of activities and events that we can do and do well. This required us to really focus on our goals and make sure that any program or event that we proposed supported our goals. We also had to be honest in what we could achieve in the short and long term. Unfortunately, not everything that was proposed could be done but by taking a realistic approach to the resources we have available we hope to be able to meet our goals and then build on them over time.












INTERNATIONAL PROGRAM

SEASON TO START EARLIER - MAY 4 TO SEPT 1

- Include more cross conference games
- Creation of a conference chair role and responsibility document
- Updated events notice / rules
- Viability of team model and age grades model
 - First option: if two or more clubs do not have numbers for a team in an age grade clubs will be encouraged to merge players to form one viable team
 - Second option: only after first option has been exhausted. age grades to be merged at the higher age grade or players allowed to play up to form a viable team
 - Requires board approval

MATARIKI

The Matariki tournament concept brought inpurpose to our sport and acknowledges our community, contributes to why we are here, valuing what we have and ensuring our future.

Our senior and junior players have set a new standard for inline hockey, not just just because they are talented individuals, but also because they exhibit respect, character, positive attitudes and a desire for our sport to develop through dedication and comitment.

Matariki gave the sport and continues to give to the sport in areas, where the disconnect between our rangitahi (15-18 year olds) can be offered a new pathway through the princples of Kaitiakitanga (Leadership & Accountability), Whakaiti (humility), Whanaungatanga (building relationships) and Manaakitanga (maintaining relationships).

Teams are named after eight of the nine stars of the Matariki cluster and led by respected senior players who have proven leadership and mentoring skills along with integrity, experience and knowledge of the game. The event is empowering to all participants, provides a platform to share enthusiasm and positivity and gives Inline Hockey New Zealand an opportunity to showcase our sport to spectators, families and stream across the country.
