- Lack of rink time available

Solutions:

- Difficult to grow the sport
 - grassroots/development camps, LTP, coaching initiatives
- Draw

- □ More competition
 - More options for 2023 onwards both nationally and internationally
- Lack of rink time
 - Better planning draw completed earlier to give venues notice
