Groups:

- 2026 an event?
- Men 16/18/21 are separated into Narch groups
- As per plan they are to work through the ranks at Narch then go to Worlds in Mens comps in every grade for a 5 − 10 year plan, envisage this to be possible 3 campaigns away
- SM into WRG at this stage this is not a viable option with interest received

Sunday Review of Saturdays discussion points

Conference Working Group Feedback:

Alethea joined the meeting to review the feedback from the working group – to be discussed further for potential solutions but the general feeling is there is not a one size fits all solution to improve the current conference system but change does need to occur to improve the current model including:

- Issues around geographical travel and costs for the Southern area
- The season to be longer with as many games as possible (after Bauer Cup to end of August)
- JW/IW/SW split
- JFOH to return to Nationals
- League games and cross over tournaments
- Cost equalisation be reviewed in the future
- Pathways Club, Nationals, Interconference, NZ Team
- Dispensation process to be maintained
- No clashes with ice so people can play both

Interconference Tournament Feedback:

Adrian and Gillian joined the meeting to review feedback

- Feedback is around timing, location, senior participation, the process and journey
- Like the All Star type conference but not so keen on the concept introduced
- Disparity of talent across regions
- Recruit, develop, retain needs to be the mantra
- Change to Labour weekend does clash with Ice camp for all 16u players
- Rotating location this is liked but need advance notice to plan
- Senior participation visibility to the players
- Process more notice for trials, a development squad assembled, clarity on the criteria used to select both players and coaching staff, coaching selection and vetting process is unclear, no feedback provided to players or to coaches on selection or non selection

Conference Model:

- Date change start weekend of 4 May 2024 to 1 Sept 2024
- More cross conference games
- How to ensure those clubs with low numbers survive?

Option 1: Merging clubs/teams for the viability of a grade:

- register with existing club by Friday 15 March 2024
- Clubs would advise gaps/viability of teams
- Draw out ready for Friday 12 April 2024

Option 2: To merge age grades together and play the higher

Both options to be at Boards discretion and once club numbers for grades are known
